

Interiors feature ceilings up to 10 feet high, wide plank European white oak flooring, and a refined finish palette hand-selected by Robert A.M. Stern Architects. The west-facing primary suite boasts a walk-in closet and five-fixture bath with deep soaking tub and glass-enclosed walk-in shower.

Residence #10F is situated on Claremont Hall's tranquil northwestern corner and incorporates an 8' bay picture window in the open-concept living room. All three bedrooms have generous closet space, and the primary suite boasts a walk-in.

Spanning 1,036 square feet, **Residence #12G** features one sizeable bedroom, two full baths and a sizable, flexible study space that can accommodate a variety of uses. The corner living room enjoys a sunny southern exposure with views to the Midtown skyline, and western views overlooking the grandeur of Riverside Church, Riverside Park, and the Hudson River. An expansive L-shaped kitchen with breakfast bar, custom Italian cabinetry, and paneled appliance package from Bosch, including a wine refrigerator, opens to the graceful living and dining space.



Claremont Hall's carefully curated amenity collection was designed in partnership with CetraRuddy Architects, and provides space and resrouces for the replenishment of mind, body, and spirit. A fitness center overlooks the seminary's courtyard and features a separate movement studio. A library with leatherbound classics is ideal for remote work, and a soundproof Rehearsal Hall music room and Workshop for artists let creatives meet their needs in style.

The original Union dining hall has been converted to the Refectory Pool, a 48-foot lap pool with the original soaring ceilings, Gothic windows, and chandeliers. To really make a splash, the pool can be converted into a staged floor for private events. Additional amenties include on-site parking, Little Castle children's playroom, and Parkview Lounge and Terrace overlooking Riverside Church, Grant's Tomb, and Sakura Park.
